Since 1993 International Academy has provided private educational services for international students in grades K-12 living in St. Petersburg, Russia. Our vision is to see students transformed through a love of learning and our mission is to deliver exceptional international Christian educational programs in English.

The School

The school is housed in the historical center of St. Petersburg Russia on Bolshaya Kanushenaya street (Большая Коношенная ул.) at the Finnish House. We have several classrooms including a science lab, mixed media/fine arts room and music performing hall. The school technology is on a one-to-one basis: each student has their own tablet or laptop. The school rents a local gymnasium for physical educational classes.

The Students

Since 1993, International Academy of Saint Petersburg students have come from more than thirty countries, the largest groups being the U.S., South Korea, and Japan. Currently, the school has students from 15 countries. For this reason IASP does not rank its students.

Instruction is given in English, and students must demonstrate minimum English language proficiency to enter high school. Other world languages included in our curriculum are Russian, German, Korean and Japanese.

Curriculum

International Academy offers an American college preparatory program. We use the AERO standards for international education for U.S. embassy schools. Our

internationally recognized diploma provides exceptional global opportunities for our students evidenced in the list of schools attended by our graduates.

Further, as an official international examination center, we provide Advanced Placement (AP) and ACT college entrance examinations. Through our Advanced Placement courses, students can show exceptional aptitude in order to enter top universities and institutes worldwide. Full credit classes meet five times a week and half-credit classes meet two to three hours per week; a credit correlates to 120 academic hours.



International Accreditations and Russian Licensure

We are accredited by both the Middle States Association and Association of Christian Schools International. In addition, we are a licensed non-profit educational institution for supplementary education by the Russian Federation's Committee for Education in St. Petersburg.

Our Community

St. Petersburg, the cultural capital of Russia is a center for music and the arts. The city is also a base for international businesses and consulates. Classes at International Academy engage with the cultural heritage of St. Petersburg through experiences at places such as the Hermitage, the Russian Museum, and Mariinsky Theater.

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Grade Point Average and Class Rank

Semester course grades are reported numerically on transcripts. These are used to determine GPA on a four point scale. Semester grades are used to calculate the cumulative GPA. International Academy does not rank students because the majority do not attend our school all of their high school years. Our students come from varied educational backgrounds including international schools with different grading scales.
